

Why did one punch entry result in more than one payroll entry?

A punch entry could result in more than one payroll entry if it was edited or previously paid. These scenarios could lead to the creation of a compensating entry, which is an additional entry that compensates for the change that was made to the original entry (e.g., edit or cancel).
